



Information and Policies

Classes will begin on Monday, September 11, 2017. Students register just once starting in fall for the school year, payable in three payments.

1st trimester (11 weeks): September 11th - November 26th, due upon registration

2nd trimester (12 weeks): November 27th - March 3rd, due November 4th

3rd trimester (12 weeks): March 4th - June 4th, due February 17th

Costume fees due Dec. 2nd.

Winter Break will be observed December 18th – January 1st.

Spring Break will be observed the week of March 26th – March 30th.

No classes on Halloween, October 31st or Thanksgiving weekend, Nov. 23rd and 24th

No classes New Year's Day Jan. 1st or Memorial Day, May 29th.

Last day of classes will be on Monday, June 4th, 2018.

Dress Rehearsal at DeForest PAC is tentatively set for Thursday, June 7th at 4pm.

Spring Recital is tentatively set for Saturday, June 9th, 2pm and 6pm, and Sunday, June 10th, 2pm.

Registration Fee:

A non-refundable \$25.00 registration fee per student is due at the time of registration.

Payment of tuition for first trimester holds your child's spot in the class.

Tuition may be paid by the full year, trimester, or monthly. For the monthly payment option, a one-time per year \$25 convenience fee will be assessed. You will need to sign an agreement that if paying monthly, you are still responsible for the trimester's full tuition.

Any tuition not received by the due date (Sept. 11, Nov. 4, or Feb. 17) will be charged a \$15.00 late charge. If tuition is still not paid after two weeks (Sept. 25, Nov. 18, or March 3), another \$15.00 late charge will be assessed.

ULDC accepts cash, checks, or credit cards. At in person registration, only cash or checks will be accepted. If registering online through Studio Director, ULDC will also accept credit/debit cards with a 3% service charge. Tuition is non-refundable, but a credit can be applied to future sessions if needing to withdraw.

Requirements for Pointe and Level 2 and Level 3 Ballet:

Students must be evaluated to be placed into Pointe and Level 2 or Level 3 Ballet. Students must take at least two ballet classes per week to be in Pointe and Level 2 or Level 3 Ballet. Pointe students must take the ballet class prior to their pointe class so they are properly warmed up for pointe.

Recital:

ULDC holds a recital each spring. This gives students an opportunity to be part of a professional performance on stage in costume. The recital gives students the opportunity to show their family and friends what they have accomplished throughout the year. The recital will be held at the DeForest High School PAC. Each family will be able to purchase tickets to attend the spring recital. The recital is professionally videotaped, which families may purchase if they wish. A professional photographer is available to take pictures of the dancers in their costumes.

Costume Fees:

Each student will receive a costume for each class that they are in to perform in the spring recital. There is a \$55.00 fee per class for all dancers age 3-8 (pre-k to 2nd/3rd grade), a \$70.00 fee per class for all dancers age 9 and above (4th-6th grade and up). All costume fees are due by December 3rd. ***Any costume fee not received by the due date will be charged a \$15.00 late charge.***

What to wear:

All female dancers should have their hair pulled up, away from their face and secured.

Pre-Ballet, Ballet and Pointe – Leotard, tights, and pink leather or canvas ballet shoes/pointe shoes. Ballet skirts or fitted dance shorts may be worn in addition to leotard and tights.

Lyrical and Contemporary – Leotard, tights, and dance paws or barefoot. Ballet skirts or fitted dance shorts may be worn in addition to leotard and tights.

Jazz – Leotard, tights, and black jazz shoes. Fitted dance shorts or fitted jazz pants may be worn in addition to leotard and tights. Absolutely no baggy t-shirts, pants or shorts.

Hip-Hop – T-shirts, tanks, sweatpants, or shorts. Black hip-hop shoes.

Tap – Leotard, tights, and black tap shoes. Fitted dance shorts or fitted jazz pants may be worn in addition to leotard and tights. Absolutely no baggy t-shirts, pants or shorts.

Male Dancers – Attire for any of the above classes is jazz pants, sweat pants, shorts or pants that you can easily move in and a t-shirt or tank top. Shoes should be black ballet, black jazz, black tap, paws or dance sneakers. Absolutely no jeans.
