#### STUDENT REGISTRATION AND TUITION:

A non-refundable \$25.00 registration fee per student is due at the time of registration. Students register just once starting in fall for the school year, payable in three payments.

# Payment of tuition for the first trimester holds your child's spot in the class.

Tuition may be paid by the full year, trimester, or monthly. For the monthly payment option, a one-time per year \$50 convenience fee will be assessed. You will need to sign an agreement that if paying monthly, you are still responsible for the trimester's full tuition. Any tuition not received by the due date (Sept. 8, Nov. 7, or Feb. 20) will be charged a \$15.00 late charge. If tuition is still not paid after two weeks (Sept. 22, Nov. 21, or March 6), another \$15.00 late charge will be assessed.

### **Multi-Class Family Discount:**

2 classes = 2% Discount, 3 classes = 3% Discount, 4 classes = 4% Discount, 5 classes = 5% Discount \*Private classes are not included in the class packages or the multi-class discount. If one dancer is taking more than 10 classes, each additional class is \$150.

\*\*ULDC accepts cash, checks, or credit cards. With online registration through Studio Director, ULDC will accept credit/debit cards with a 4% service charge. If the check or cash option is chosen, payment must be made within 48 hours to hold the spot in the class(es). Tuition is non-refundable, but a credit can be applied to future sessions if needing to withdraw.

#### MAKING UP MISSED CLASSES:

If a student misses a class, that student may attend any other class of his/her grade level. Please email us at ultimateleap@gmail.com so we can let the instructor know you will be making up a class.

# **REQUIREMENTS FOR POINTE AND LEVEL 2/3/4/5 BALLET:**

Students must be evaluated to be placed into pointe and/or Level 2/3/4/5 Ballet. Students must take at least two ballet classes per week to be in pointe and/or Level 2/3/4/5 Ballet. Pointe students must take the ballet class prior to their pointe class so they are properly warmed up for pointe. If students are unable to attend one of their two ballet classes in a week, they are expected to come to another ballet class on the schedule. Pointe dancers are strongly encouraged to take two pointe classes per week, but will only be charged for one pointe class.

#### REQUIREMENT FOR LYRICAL:

Must be enrolled in a ballet class to take lyrical.

## **REQUIREMENTS FOR SOLOS/DUETS/TRIOS:**

Dancers must enroll and attend two ballet classes per week at ULDC, and must enroll and attend class in the genre of the solo/duet/trio. When registering for a solo, duet, or trio, this time commitment is for learning and rehearsing a routine to be stage ready, not a set number of classes.

### **RECITAL:**

ULDC holds a recital each spring. This gives students an opportunity to be part of a professional performance on stage in costume. The recital gives students the opportunity to show their family and friends what they have accomplished throughout the year. All students must attend the dress rehearsal to participate in the recital. The recital is tentatively scheduled to be held at the Sun Prairie West High School. Each family will be able to purchase tickets to attend the spring recital. The recital is professionally videotaped, which families may purchase if they wish. A professional photographer is available to take pictures of the dancers in their costumes.

#### **COSTUME FEES:**

Each student will receive a costume for each class that they are in to perform in the spring recital. There is a \$70.00 fee per class for all dancers age 3-8 (pre-k to 2nd/3rd grade), and an \$85.00 fee per class for all dancers age 9 and above (4th-6th grade and up). All costume fees are due by December 5<sup>th</sup>.

Any costume fee not received by the due date will be charged a \$15.00 late charge.

#### WHAT TO WEAR:

All dancers should have their hair pulled up, away from their face and secured.

- **Pre-Ballet, Ballet and Pointe** Leotard, pink tights, and pink leather or canvas ballet shoes/pointe shoes. Ballet skirts or fitted dance shorts may be worn in addition to leotard and pink tights. Hair needs to be in a bun or up and secured…no ponytails.
- Lyrical and Contemporary Leotard, tights, and barefoot or dance specific contemporary socks. Fitted dance shorts may be worn in addition to leotard and tights.
- **Jazz** Leotard, tights, and tan jazz shoes. Fitted dance shorts or fitted jazz pants may be worn in addition to leotard and tights. Absolutely no baggy t-shirts, pants or shorts.
- **Hip-Hop** Tanks, sweatpants, shorts. Clean (never worn outside) white sneakers.
- **Tap** Leotard, tights, and black tap shoes. Fitted dance shorts or fitted jazz pants may be worn in addition to leotard and tights.
- Male Ballet Dancers Solid colored tank/t-shirt and solid colored pants/shorts (nothing baggy)
- **Male Dancers** Attire for any of the other styles is jazz pants, sweat pants, shorts or pants that you can easily move in and a t-shirt or tank top. Shoes should be black ballet, black jazz, black tap, white sneakers.

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
